Designing glass has been my passion for more than 20 years. I originally wanted to be a painter, but the legendary Professor Zbigniew Horbowy sparked within me a love for art glass when I enrolled at the Wrocław Academy of Fine Arts. My first creations were collections of vases, cake plates, and candle sticks, which received many awards and accolades, including ELLE Decoration's PRO DECO award. My plates are now also part of the permanent exhibition at the National Museum in Warsaw. Today, however, I use art glass primarily to create art objects or lighting fixture designs, including lamps and chandeliers for hotels,

and art furniture such as coffee tables and mirrors. I am happy that my designs receive so much recognition at exhibitions held in such places as Milan, London, New York, and Dubai. The awards which are of particular importance to me are the All on Design award for my Wave lamp, the London Surface Design Show award for my table tops, and the Milan Design Selection 2019 and 2020 Archiproducts award. I strive to combine the unique beauty of art glass with the utility of the material in everyday contexts. It is my hope that my art objects and designs will be to your liking.

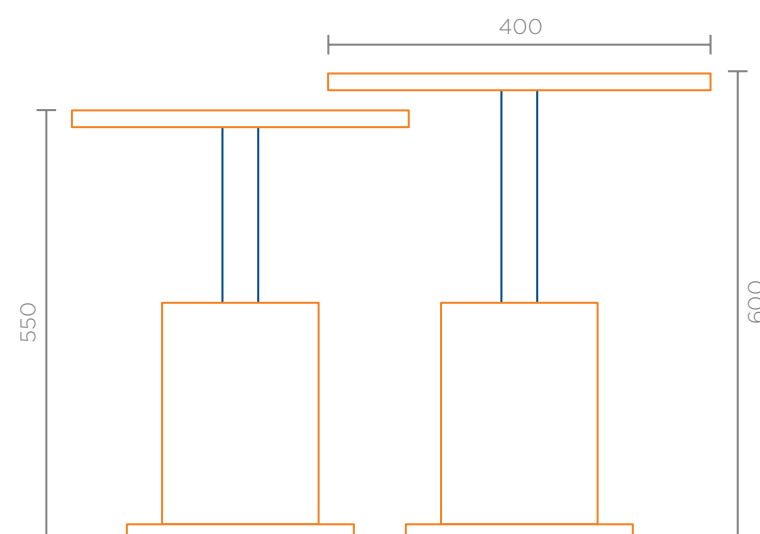




FABLES GLASSTRICO

Side tables

The Glasstrico collection is a response to the ZeroWaste trend in the world. The table tops are made of recycled broken glass elements, melted at very high temperature. This is the author's method with the rights reserved by the studio. The primary colours are white, black/white; blue/white and brown/white. Each piece is handmade and unique.

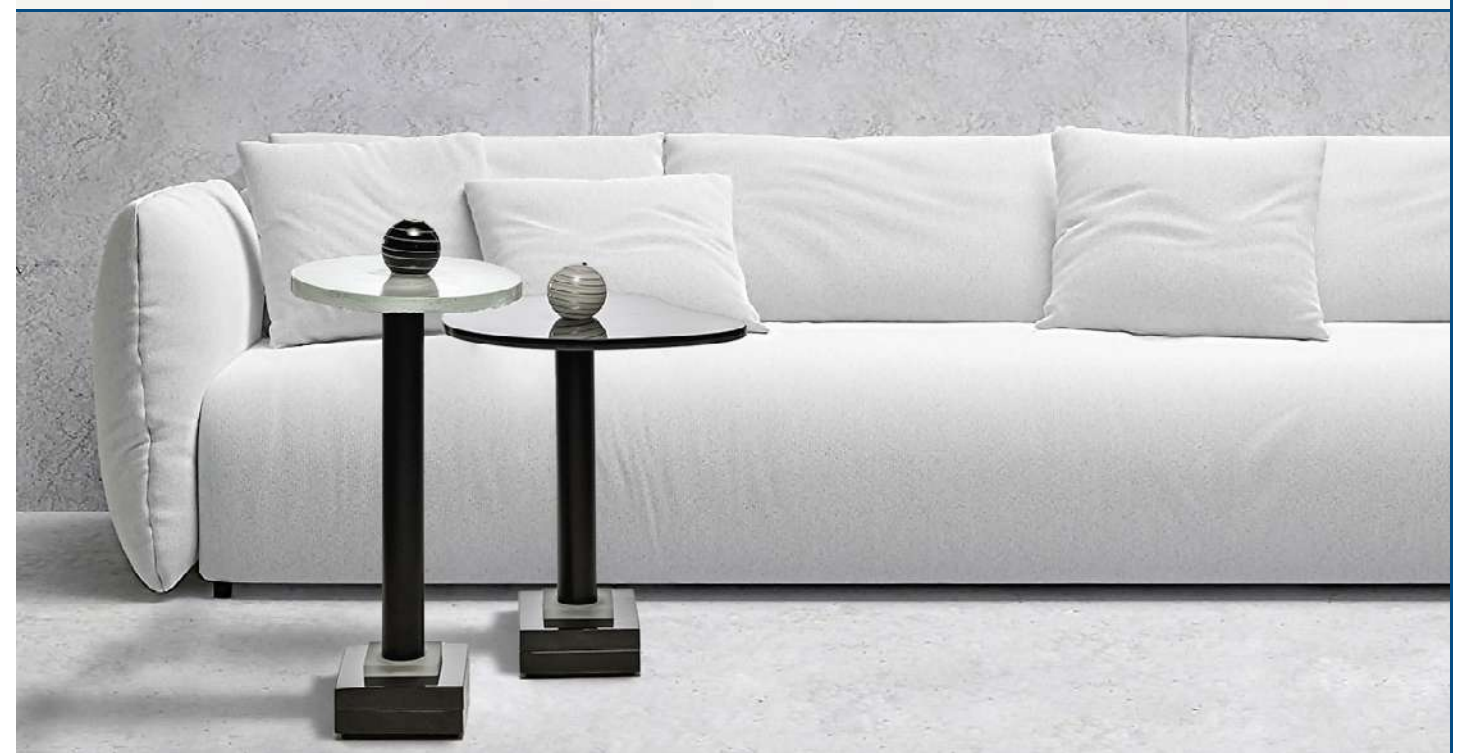

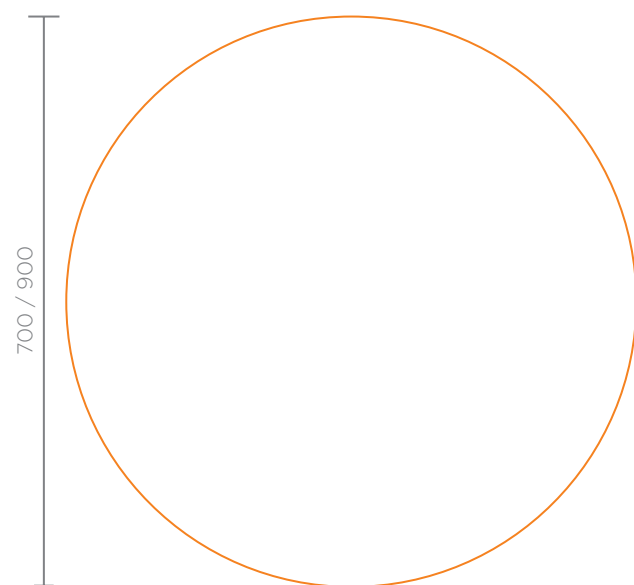

GLASS PAINTINGS

BIG BLUE collection

A painting made of art glass is not painted, but just like Venetian glass Murano is made of glass stained with metal oxides, so the color of the glass will never change. Each image will be slightly different, metal oxides react with each other under the influence of high temperatures, creating the final color composition. A limited and signed collection, usually 80 or 90 cm in diameter.

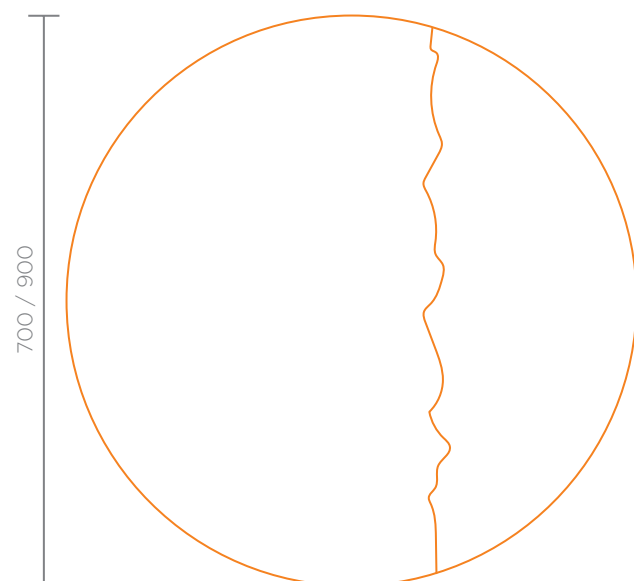

Glass paintings and mirrors

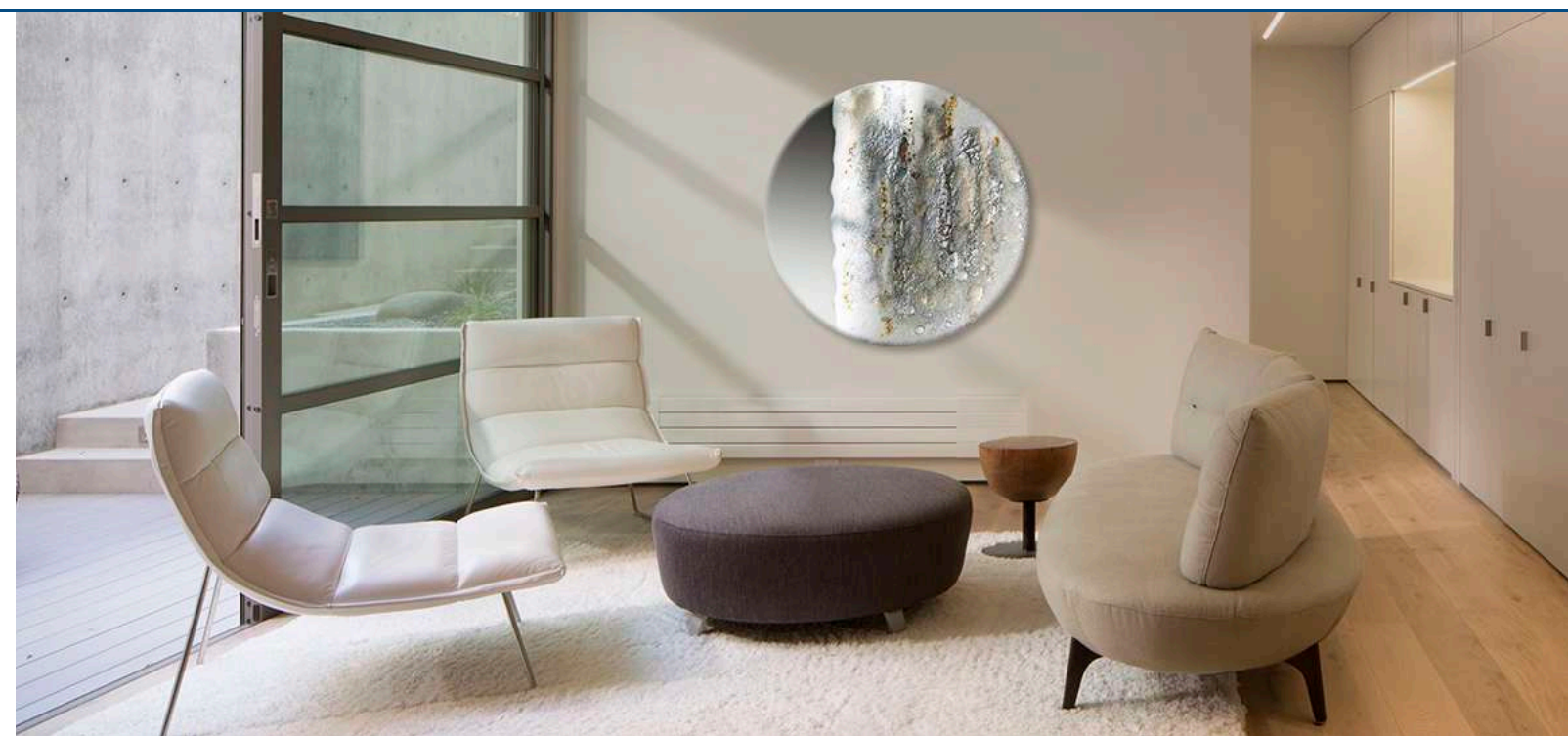
Sometimes mirror elements are used in the images, depending on the aspect ratio, the image may also have utility functions. Each image will be slightly different, metal oxides react with each other under the influence of high temperatures, creating the final color composition. A limited and signed collection, usually 80 or 90 cm in diameter.

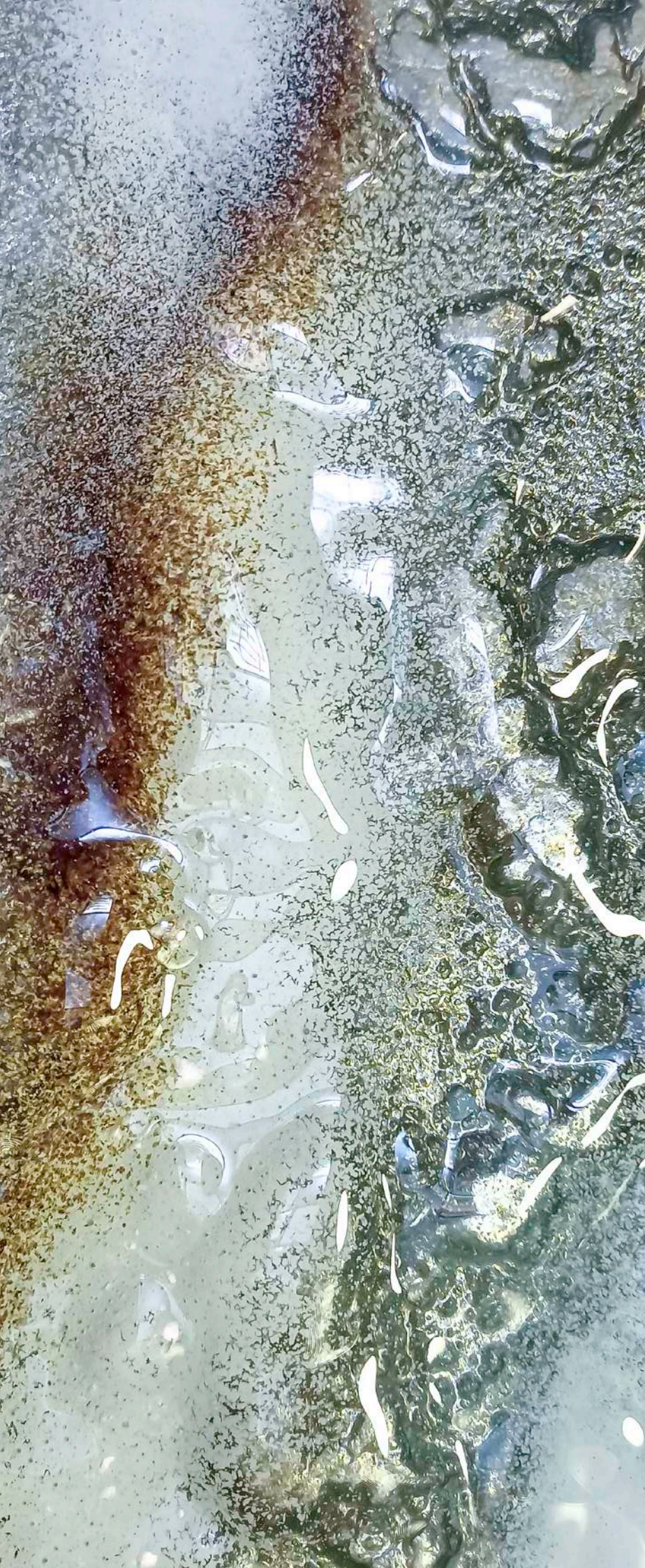

Fountains

Glass fountains are rare, but this material in combination with water, creates an extraordinary effect. An example is the glass sculpture, which is also a water feature in a hotel lobby. This type of glass object becomes the focal point of the entire interior, creating its unique atmosphere.

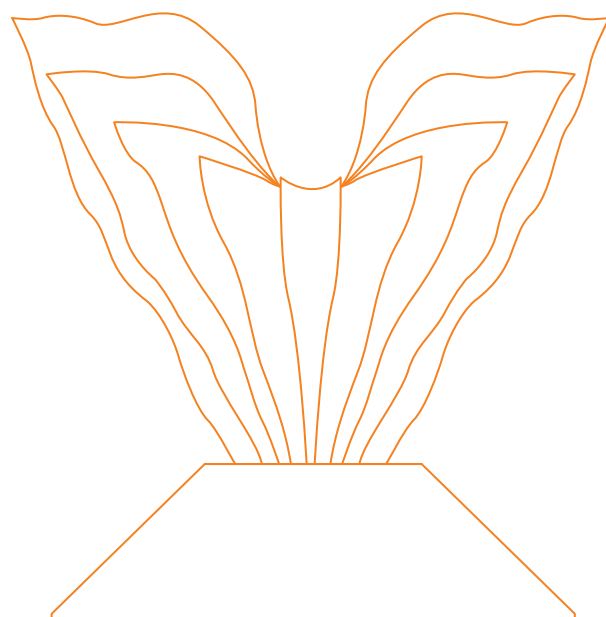

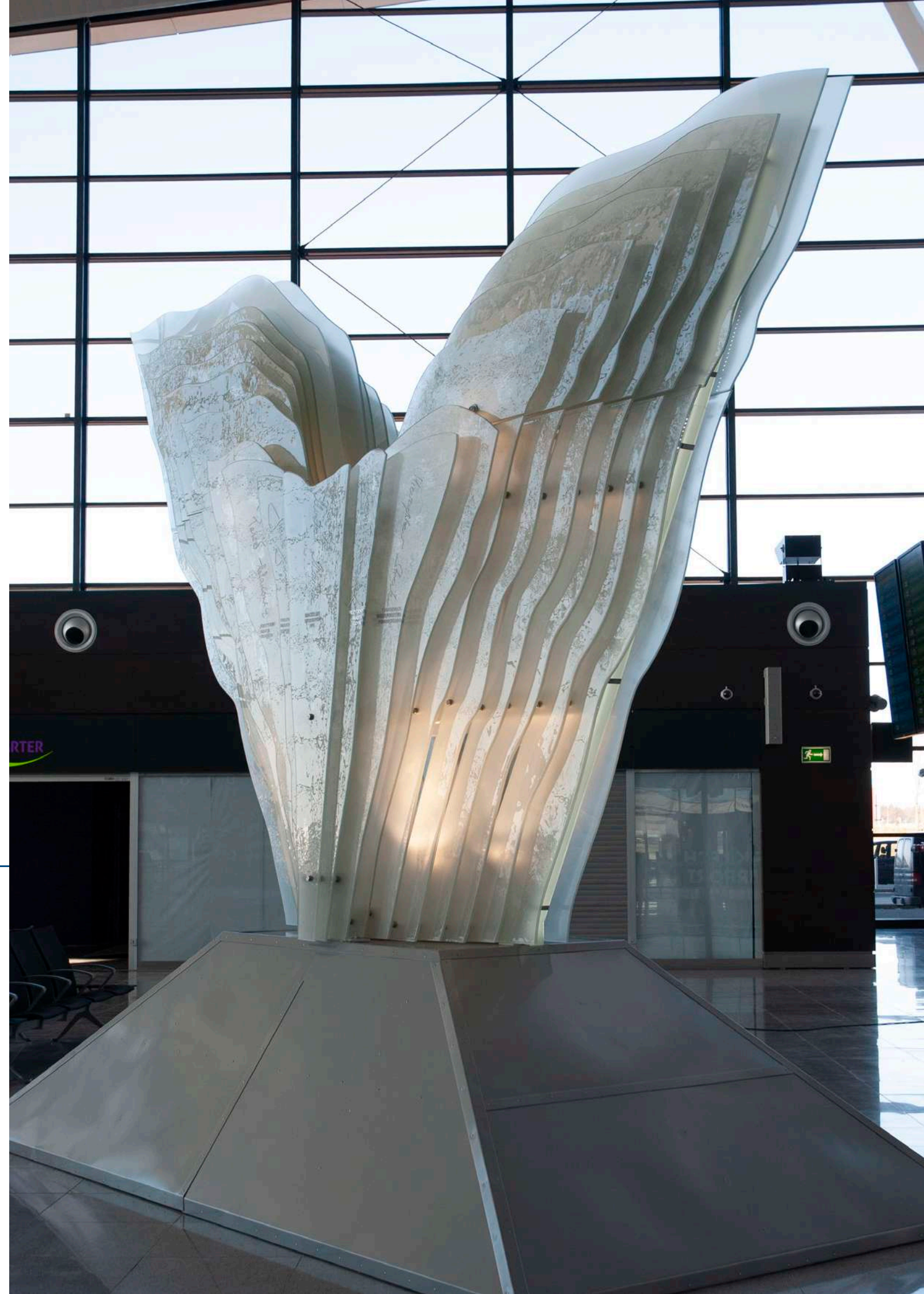
Wings of Freedom

The sculpture „Wings of Freedom” was created in honor of the President of Poland, Lech Walesa, funded by the mayors of Gdansk, Sopot and Gdynia. The monumental sculpture, 3.5 m high with a wingspan of 6.5 m, weighed 3.5 tons and was made of fused and hot formed art glass. The metal skeleton concealed additional lighting that illuminated the sculpture from the inside, making it an extraordinary impression in the evening.

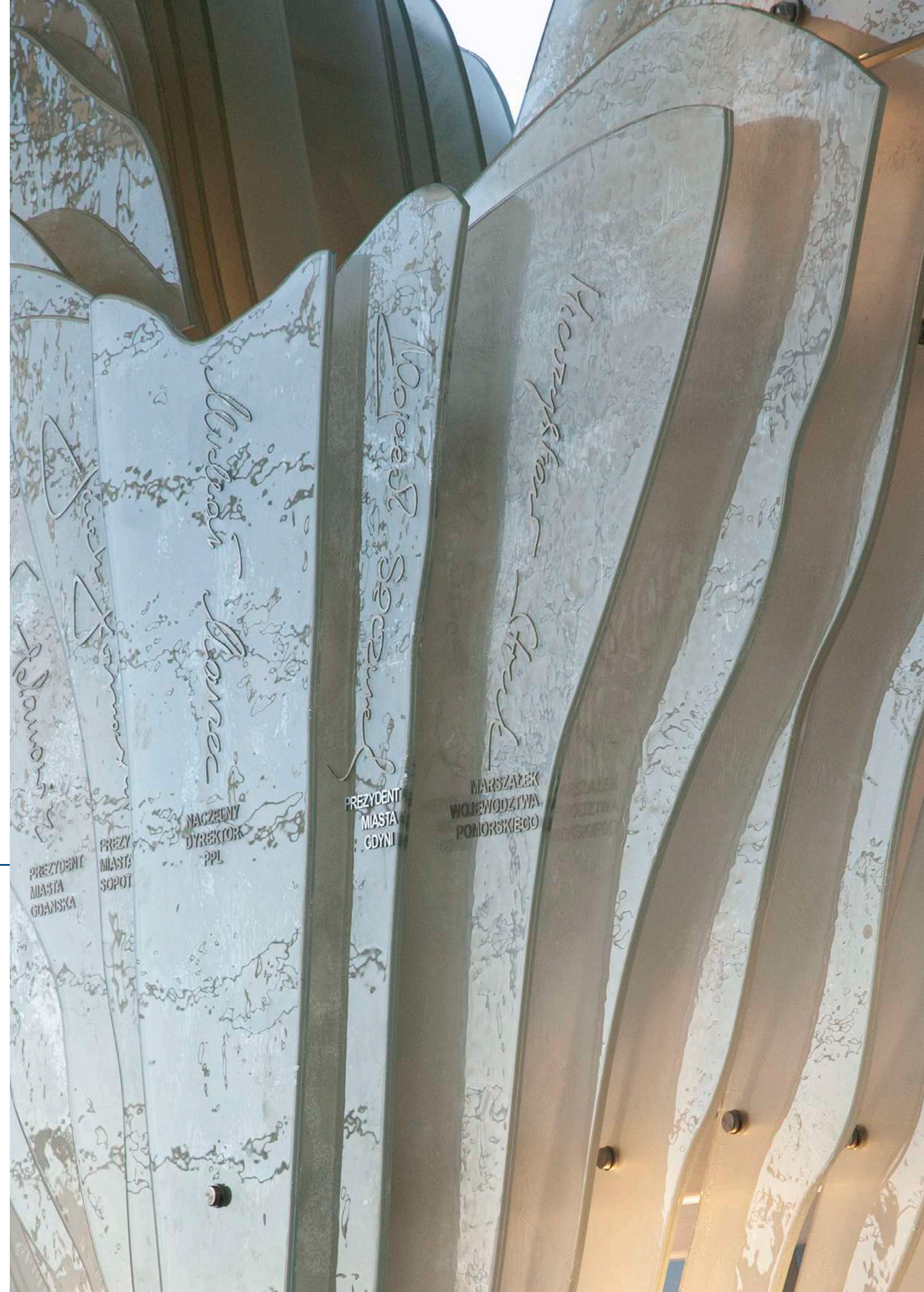

Wings of Freedom

The sculptures are made both on request and through the artist's own work. Various techniques are used to produce glass, often combined with metal, stone or wood. Large objects decorate city squares and public interiors or hotel lobbies, small sculptures were often presented as a prestigious gift, among others by the President of Poland, members of the government or the European Parliament. Several glass objects are in the collection of the National Museum in Warsaw.





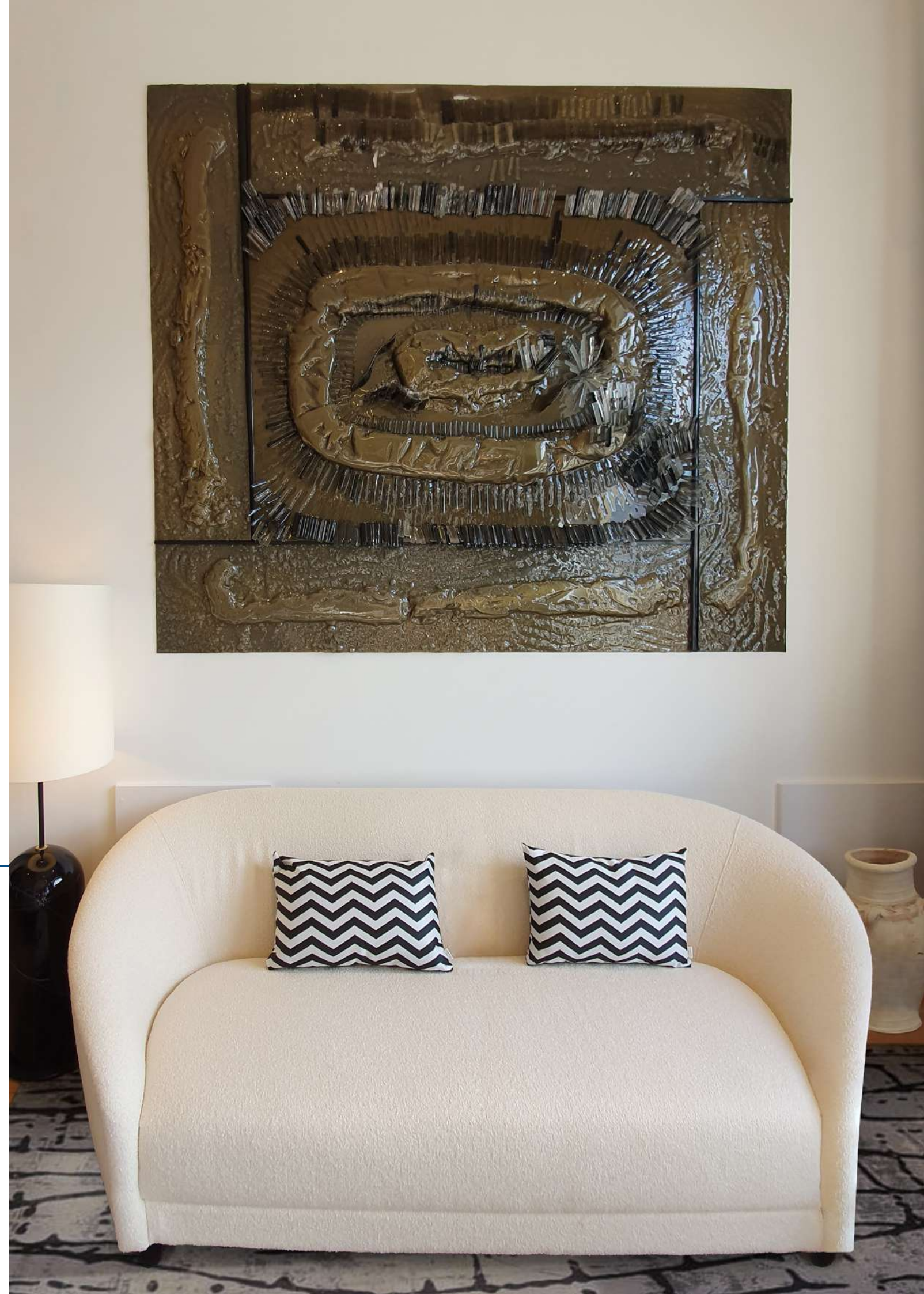

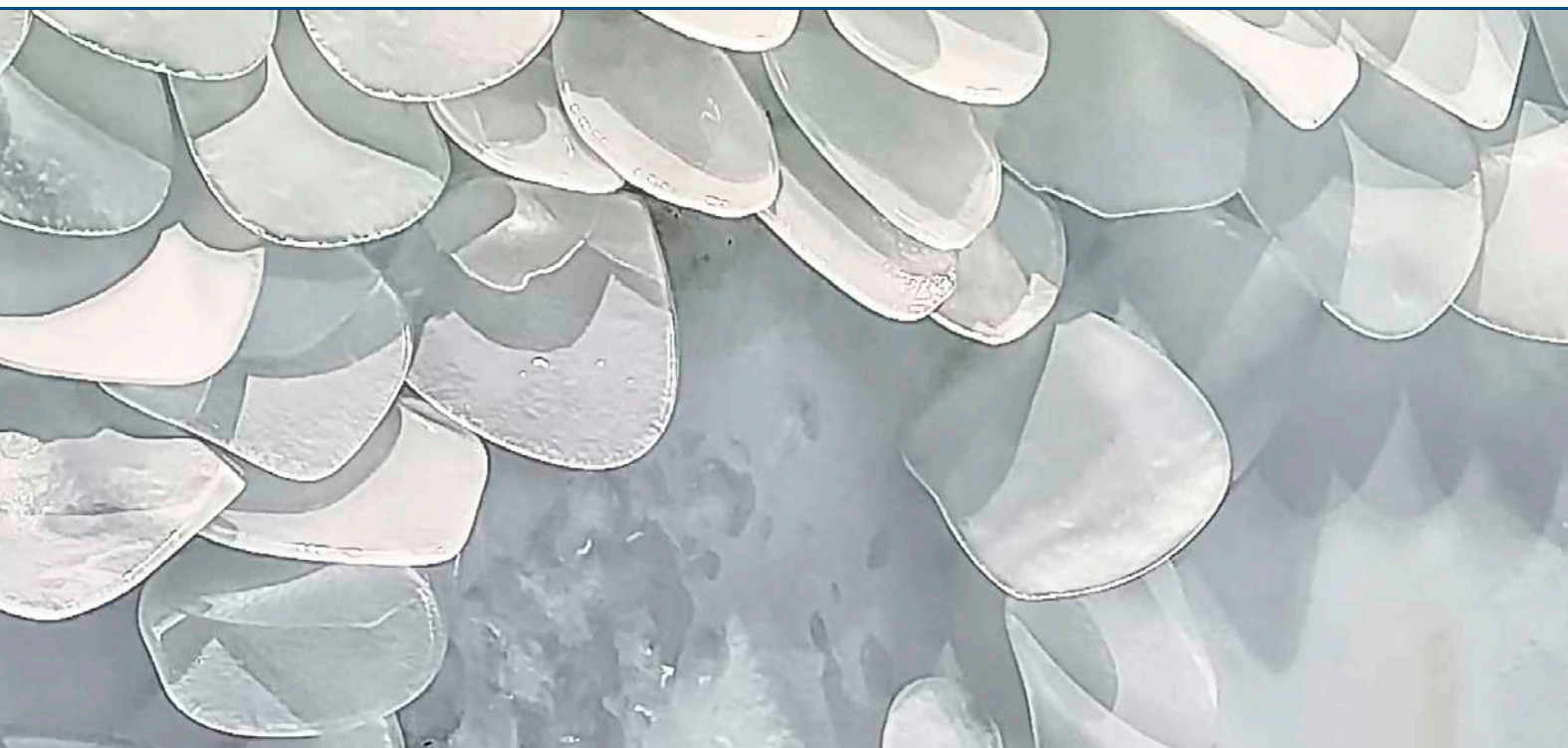

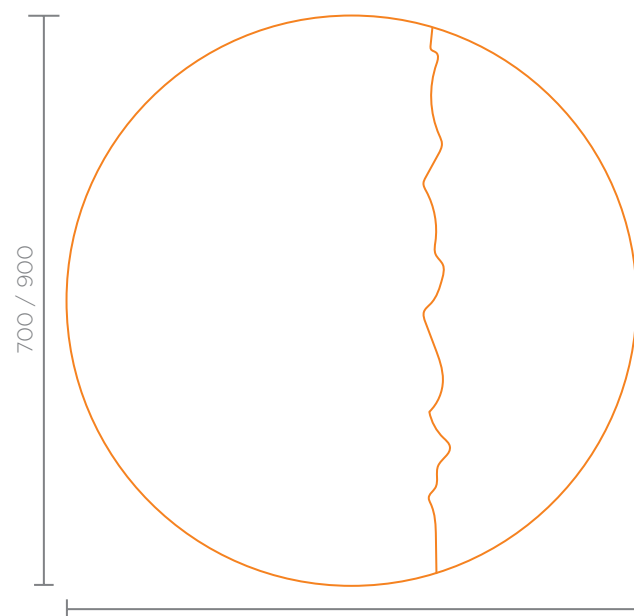

Time Stoper

Art glass is not an easy material to work with, especially when it comes to sculpting. Still, I am always happy to take on a new challenge. Many of my sculptures have been designed for private buyers or companies as decorations for already prestigious interiors.

The sculpture next to it, TIME STOPER, symbolizes Time, the Universe in which our experiences, moments in life, often forgotten by us, are hidden. Additionally, small glass elements with engraved dates of important events, names or places that were important to someone are added to the sculpture. Thanks to this, every time we take out such a pebble-glass, we recall an important person or an event in our life, remembered anew and saved, frozen in time for a moment.

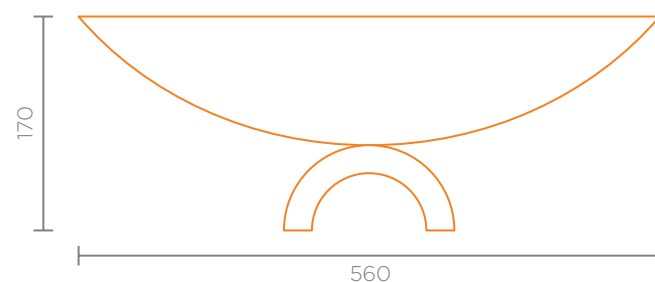

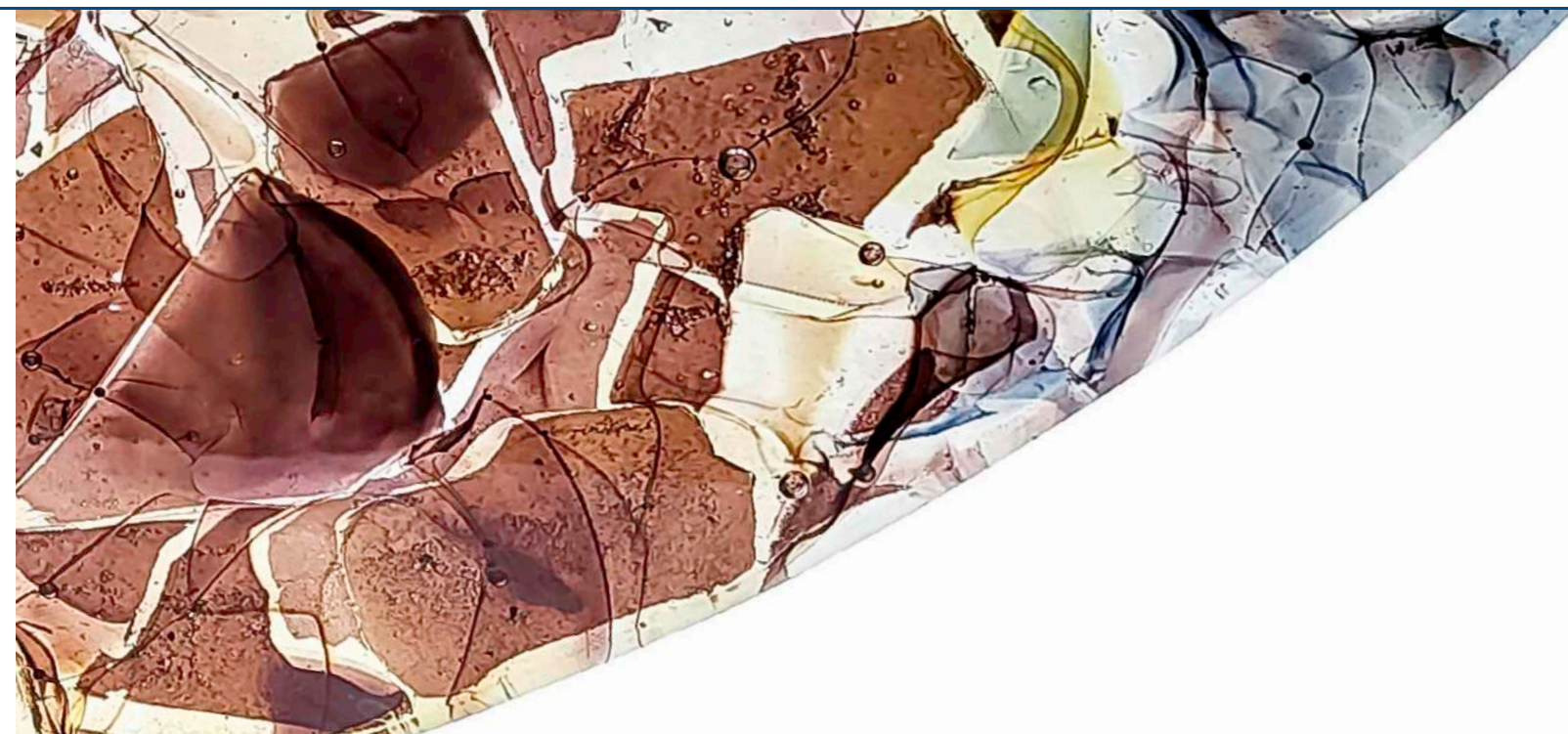
Universe

Blue ocean

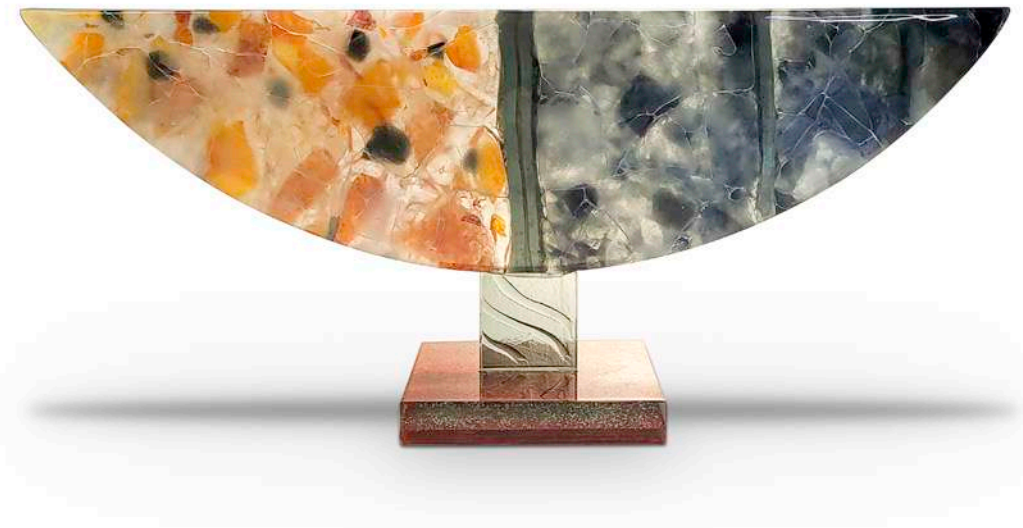
The BLUE OCEAN 2 sculpture for me is associated with water, blue, depth, but also peace and silence.

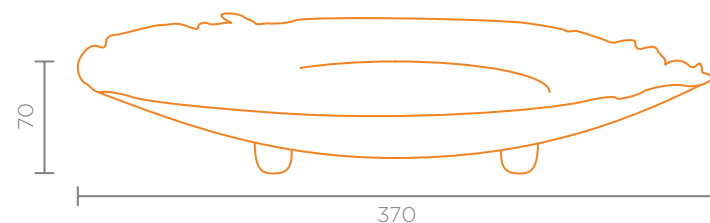
